FY2018 JGSDF oversea exercise in the United States of America (RIMPAC2018)

JGSDF will participate in RIMPAC2018 as a part of FY2018 oversea exercise in the United States of America.

1 Purpose

JGSDF will dispatch its units to multilateral exercise "RIMPAC2018" hosted by the U.S. Navy; to enhance joint bilateral anti-ship combat capability in cooperation with the U.S. Army and JMSDF through Japan-U.S. combined anti-ship combat exercise; to maintain and enhance amphibious operation capability and interoperability between JSDF and U.S. Forces through amphibious exercise; to improve staff capability by attending HA/DR exercise.
