

Japan-Philippines Bilateral Training on Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief

From July 5 to July 8, 2021 the Koku-Jieitai (Japan Air Self-Defense Force) C-130H conducted the first bilateral training with the Philippine Air Force (PAF) on Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief at Clark Air Base, Mabalacat City, Pampanga, Philippines. In addition to the 14 days quarantine period for their entry into the Philippines and their return to Japan, the training was conducted with thorough measures to prevent the infection of COVID-19 and further deepened the cooperation between the two Air Forces to realize the Free and Open Indo-Pacific. The Koku-Jieitai will continue to make good use of the strong relationship between the two Air Forces and work together with the PAF to further strengthen the coordination and capabilities, as well as to fulfill a proper role for the regional peace and stability.
