

Official visit to Japan, Chief of the Air Staff, Indian Air Force

From May 16 to 20, the Koku-Jieitai (JASDF) officially invited Air Chief Marshal Vivek Ram Chaudhari, Chief of the Air Staff, Indian Air Force to Japan, and strengthened its relationship and enhanced mutual understanding with the Indian Air Force through exchange of views with General Izutsu, Chief of Staff, Koku-Jieitai and visits to bases and units of the Koku-Jieitai.
