

# Tour for MAAT members

From July 6 to 8, the Koku-Jieitai (Japan Air Self-Defense Force) held a tour for members of Military Attaché Association in Tokyo at Chitose Air Base to promote understanding of the mission and units, and 28 Defense Attachés from 24 countries participated.

MAAT members visited the 201st Tactical Fighter Squadron of the 2nd Air Wing, Chitose Air Traffic Control Squadron and Special Airlift Group.

In the 201st TFS, they were briefed on the emergency launch (scramble), which is a measure against violations of the Japanese Airspace, and toured F-15J fighter jet on site. In Chitose ATCS, they were informed about Chitose ATCS's mission, which handles a wide variety of aircraft such as fighter jets and airliners, as well as the largest traffic volumes in Japan.

In the Special Airlift Group, they were briefed on the duties "Transportation of state guests", and toured the Japanese Government Aircraft.

MAAT members boarded the C-2 Cargo aircraft from Chitose and returned to Iruma to promote understanding of air self-defense force equipment.
