Subject Matter Expert Exchange on Air Warning and Control with Mongolian Air Force Command

On December 18 and 19, the Western Aircraft Control and Warning Wing welcomed four officers from the Air Force Command, Mongolian Armed Forces, and conducted a subject matter expert exchange (SMEE) on air control and warning. The SMEE was an unit-level exchange between Japan and Mongolia air services, coming on the heels of the SMEE on air traffic control held last October.
