

Strengthening the relationship between Koku-Jieitai and the U.S. Air Force

On April 17, General UCHIKURA Hiroaki, Chief of Staff, Koku-Jieitai (Japan Air Self-Defense Force) visited the United States for the first time since appointed as the CoS, and held a meeting with General CQ Brown, JR, Chief of Staff of the U.S. Air Force, to strengthen the bilateral relationship.

On April 18, Lieutenant General OGASAWARA Takuto, Vice Chief of Staff, Koku-Jieitai talked with General Wilsbach, Commander of Pacific Air Forces, at the Ministry of Defense, Japan.

Through high-level exchanges between the two air services of both countries, they shared a renewed recognition of the severe security environment surrounding Japan and the importance of the Japan-U.S. Alliance, and further reinforced the bilateral relationship. Koku-Jieitai will continue to maintain close cooperation with the United States.
