

Japan-Italy Bilateral Training

From August 4 to 10, Koku-Jieitai (Japan Air Self-Defense Force) conducted training with the Italian Air Force at Komatsu Air Base.

This is the first bilateral training between Koku-Jieitai and the Italian Air Force conducted in Japan. The purpose of this training is to enhance tactical skills and promote mutual understanding, as well as further deepen defense cooperation with Italy in the Indo-Pacific region in order to contribute to realizing peace and stability of both countries.

In conjunction with the event, Lieutenant General Biavati, Operational Forces Commander, the Italian Air Force visited Japan, and Lieutenant General Suzuki, Commander, Air Defense Command, also visited Komatsu Air Base to observe the training.

Koku-Jieitai welcomes Italy's commitment to the Indo-Pacific region, and will actively promote defense cooperation and exchanges with the Italian Air Force and maintain and strengthen the cooperative relationship between Japan and Italy by enhancing the tactical skills of units and promoting mutual understanding through bilateral trainings.
