

Subject Matter Expert Exchange on Air Traffic Control with Mongolian Air Force Command

From October 23 to 27, Air Traffic Control Service Group, Mobile Air Traffic Control Squadron and Hyakuti Air Traffic Control Squadron welcomed four officers from the Air Force Command, Mongolian Armed Forces, and conducted a subject matter expert exchange on air traffic control.
