

Air Force Forum in Japan(AFFJ)

From October 14 to 18, Koku-Jieitai (JASDF) conducted Air Force Forum in Japan (AFFJ) as one of the commemorative events of its 70th anniversary.

During AFFJ, “Indo-Pacific Air chiefs-Conference in Tokyo” (InPACT) was held. Through InPACT, air chiefs of participating countries shared their views based on ‘three Is’(multi-domain Integration, human Interoperability, with great Impact).

General UCHIKURA Hiroaki, Chief of Staff, JASDF also had meetings with all the participating air chiefs and representatives to confirm that they would further deepen relationships through defense cooperation and exchanges.
