Japan-U.S.-ROK Trilateral Training

The Japan Air Self-Defense Force (JASDF) conducted a trilateral training exercise with the U.S. Air Force (USAF) and the Republic of Korea Air Force (ROKAF) to strengthen the deterrence and response capabilities of Japan-U.S. Alliance, and to further enhance trilateral security cooperation among Japan, the U.S., and the Republic of Korea.
