

Japan-U.S.-Australia Trilateral Training “Bushido Guardian 25”

On 30 September, Lieutenant General YAJIMA Masahito, Commander, Air Defense Command, and Air Vice-Marshal Harvey Reynolds, AM, Deputy Chief of Air Force, Royal Australian Air Force visited Misawa Air Base and, together with Colonel Paul T. Davidson, Commander, 35th Fighter Wing, U.S. Air Force, met the detachments. They also held a joint press conference. The leaders reaffirmed the importance of cooperation among Japan, the United States and Australia, highlighting the historic nature of the trilateral training taking place in Japan, involving F-35As from all three nations.

Koku-Jieitai will continue to enhance interoperability through Japan-U.S.-Australia trilateral trainings, while working closely with the U.S. Air Force and Royal Australian Air Force to contribute to peace and stability in the Indo-Pacific region.
