

Participation in the Indo-Pacific Regional Military WPS Advisor Course hosted by the U.S. INDOPACOM

From September 22 to October 3, JMOD and JSDF dispatched instructors and participants to the Indo-Pacific Regional Military WPS Advisor Course hosted by the U.S. Indo-Pacific Command (INDOPACOM).

Participants from 17 Indo-Pacific countries — Australia, Bangladesh, Canada, Fiji, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, New Zealand, the Philippines, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Tonga, Thailand, the United States, and Vietnam — gathered for the course.

Under the guidance of an instructor team composed of representatives from Japan, the U.S., Australia, Canada, New Zealand, and the Philippines, participants deepened their understanding of WPS through group discussions, lectures, and panel sessions.

On September 24, the Indo-Pacific Defense WPS Steering Committee Meeting was held, bringing together WPS advisors from Japan, the U.S., Australia, Canada, New Zealand, and the Philippines. The meeting featured active exchanges of views on each country's WPS initiatives and regional cooperation.
