X Only in unavoidable cases such as a disaster, please contact the administrator of the designated USFJ facility or the relevant Regional Defense Bureau before flying a drone, etc. Please be noted that flight consent from the administrator of the designated facility needs to be obtained even in such unavoidable cases.

* For the exact contact point of the prior notice (relevant police station or Coast Guard Office), please refer to the website of each prefectural police station or the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism. Prior notice form can also be obtained at the contact point of the relevant police station or Coast Guard Office.

Procedures for Drone Flights (over the designated USFJ facilities)

Application for consent to the administrator of the designated USFJ facility

For drone flights, consent from the administrator of the designated USFJ facility must be obtained (a written consent must be issued).

Prior notice to <u>the Prefectural Public Safety Commission</u> and <u>the Commander of the Regional Coast Guard</u> <u>Headquarters</u>

• Submit a prior notice with the prescribed form to the police station with jurisdiction over the designated facility and its surrounding area and the Coast Guard Headquarters (only when the designated facility and its surrounding area include water area), etc. at least 48 hours before the flight.

• The actual drone, etc. to be flown must be shown to the authorities when submitting a prior notification. However, if it is difficult to do so, it is sufficient to submit a photo of the drone, etc. instead.
