## Statistics on Scrambles during the First Quarter of FY2015

#### 1. Overall

ASDF aircraft scrambled 173 times during the first quarter of FY2015, which marked a significant decrease of 167 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year.

The breakdown of scrambles by country and region is as follows: about 33% against Russian aircraft; about 66% against Chinese aircraft; and about 1% against aircraft from other countries and regions. However, they include presumptions.

#### 2. Break down of Scrambles by Regional Air Defense Force

During the first quarter of FY2015, Northern Air Defense Force aircraft scrambled 48 times, Central Air Defense Force aircraft scrambled 6 times, Western Air Defense Force aircraft scrambled 9 times, and Southwestern Composite Air Division aircraft scrambled 110 times.

Compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year, the number of scrambles by the Southwestern Composite Air Division increased, while the number of scrambles by the other Regional Air Defense Forces decreased significantly.

### 3. Characteristics of Responses through the First Quarter of FY2015

ASDF aircraft scrambled against Russian aircraft a total of 57 times, which marked a significant decrease of 178 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year.

ASDF aircraft scrambled against Chinese aircraft a total of 114 times, which marked an increase of 10 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year.


There were no cases of the detection of airspace intrusion to be made public during the first quarter.

Scrambles against Russian surveillance aircraft and Chinese fighter aircraft were high in frequency compared to other types of aircraft of the respective countries. However, they include presumptions.




