### Statistics on scrambles through fiscal year 2018

#### 1. Overall

Japan's Air Self-Defense Force (ASDF) fighter aircraft were scrambled 999 times in FY2018 in total, which marked an increase of 95 times compared to the previous fiscal year and the second largest number since 1958 when the SDF started scrambling against aircraft intruding into Japan's territorial airspace.

A breakdown of ASDF scrambles by country and region showed about 64% against Chinese aircraft, about 34% against Russian aircraft, and about 2% against other aircraft although the numbers include estimations.

#### 2. Breakdown of Scrambles by Regional Air Defense Forces

In FY2018, fighter aircraft of the Northern Air Defense Force were scrambled 277 times, those of the Central Air Defense Force 52 times, those of the Western Air Defense Force 74 times, and those of the Southwestern Air Defense Force 596 times.

Compared to the previous fiscal year, the number of scrambles by the Western Air Defense Force and the Southwestern Air Defense Force increased, while the number of scrambles by the Northern Air Defense Force and the Central Air Defense Force decreased.

#### 3. Characteristics of Responses in FY2018

ASDF fighter aircraft were scrambled 638 times against Chinese aircraft, an increase of 138 times compared to the previous fiscal year. In FY2018, a total of 19 cases, including the case of a flight of Chinese Y-9 intelligence gathering aircraft that flew over the Pacific Ocean northeastward to off of Amami Island, and the first confirmation of Chinese Y-9 patrol aircraft, were made public as unusual flights.

ASDF fighter aircraft were scrambled 343 times against Russian aircraft, a decrease of 47 times compared to the previous fiscal year. In FY2018, a total of 16 cases, including the case of a long-range flight of Russian Tu-142 patrol aircraft that flew around Japan, and the first confirmation of Russian Su-35 fighter aircraft, were made public as unusual flights.

A large number of scrambles were conducted against Chinese fighter aircraft and Russian intelligence gathering aircraft, although this includes estimations.



## Number of Scrambles by Fiscal Year






