### Statistics on Scrambles through the First Half of FY2019

#### 1. Overall

Japan Air Self-Defense Force (JASDF) fighter aircrafts were scrambled 470 times during the first half of FY2019, a decrease of 91 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year.

The breakdown of scrambles by country and region was about 71% against Chinese aircraft, about 29% against Russian aircraft, and about 1% against other aircraft, although the countries and regions include estimation.

#### 2. Breakdown of Scrambles by Regional Air Defense Force

In the first half of FY2019, fighter aircrafts of the Northern Air Defense Force were scrambled 93 times, those of the Central Air Defense Force 19 times, those of the Western Air Defense Force 62 times, and those of the Southwestern Air Defense Force 296 times.

Compared to the previous fiscal year, the number of scrambles by the Western Air Defense Force increased, while the number of scrambles by the Northern Air Defense, Central Air Defense Force and Southwestern Air Defense Force decreased.

#### 3. Characteristics of Responses through the First Half of FY2019

JASDF fighter aircrafts were scrambled 332 times against Chinese aircraft, a decrease of 13 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year. JASDF fighter aircrafts were scrambled 135 times against Russian aircraft, a decrease of 76 times compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year.

During the first half of FY2019, 8 cases were made public as unusual flights, including a violation of territorial airspace by Russian aircraft.


A large number of scrambles were conducted against Chinese and Russian fighter aircraft, although this includes estimation.

The data above was collected between April 1 and September 30, 2019.



## Number of Scrambles by Regional Air Defense Force (Past Five Years)




