Statistics on Scrambles through the First Quarter of FY2021

1. Overall

Japan Air Self-Defense Force (JASDF) fighter aircraft were scrambled 142 times during the first quarter of FY2021.

The breakdown of scrambles by country and region was about 66% against Chinese aircraft, about 34% against Russian aircraft.

2. Breakdown of Scrambles by Regional Air Defense Force

In the first quarter of FY2021, fighter aircraft of the Northern Air Defense Force were scrambled 44 times, those of the Central Air Defense Force 2 times, those of the Western Air Defense Force 11 times, and those of the Southwestern Air Defense Force 85 times.

3. Characteristics of Responses through the First Quarter of FY2021

The JASDF fighter aircraft were scrambled 94 times against Chinese aircraft and 48 times against Russian aircraft.

During the first quarter of FY2021, 4 cases were made public as unusual flights.

It is inferred that a large number of scrambles were conducted against Chinese and Russian intelligence aircraft.



(As of June 30, 2021)




