## Chief of Japan Joint Staff, GEN Yamazaki's participation in Raisina Dialogue 2022

GEN Yamazaki, Chief of Staff, Joint Staff, visited Republic of India to participate in Raisina Dialogue 2022 from 25 to 27 April, which is cohosted by the Observer Research Foundation and Ministry of External Affairs of India.

At Raisina Dialogue 2022, GEN Yamazaki took part in a panel discussion named “Reassessing 21th Century global risk landscape” with military service chiefs and representatives from Republic of India, United Kingdom, France and Australia, where he presented and discussed the need for the Self Defense Force to work closely with allies and partners such as the United States, Australia, India and France to work for peace and stability in the region and the importance of bilateral or multilateral cooperation in line with the vision of a free and open Indo-Pacific.

On the sidelines of the dialogue, GEN Yamazaki had meetings with ADM John Christopher Aquilino, Commander, U.S. Indo-Pacific Command, GEN Angus J. Campbell, Chief of Australian Defense Force, Air Marshal BR Krishna, Chief of Integrated Defence Staff to the Chairman Chiefs of Staff Committee, and ADM David Tony Radakin, Chief of Defense, United Kingdom's Armed Forces.

They shared understanding on situational awareness in Indo-Pacific region, as well as agreed to promote their defense cooperation and engagement.
