Japan-U.S.-ROK Trilateral Exercise

Japan Maritime Self Defense Force (JMSDF), the United States (U.S.) Navy, and Republic of Korea (ROK) Navy conducted a trilateral exercise. This exercise strongly promotes trilateral cooperation to respond to regional security challenges amid an increasingly severe security environment surrounding Japan, and demonstrates the strong commitment of the three countries to secure a free and open international order based on the rule of law.
