the 46<sup>th</sup> Deployed Surface Force for Counter Piracy Enforcement (DSPE)


JS AKEBONO of the 46 DSPE responded to a distressed vessel in the Gulf of Aden. The following is the overview.

On Jan 11, JS AKEBONO spotted a distressed fishing vessel with 4 Somalian crew in the Gulf of Aden while conducting patrol in the CTF 151 area of operations. The concerned vessel was experiencing engine difficulties, therefore JS AKEBONO coordinated with CTF 151 and responded immediately to assist. The vessel was towed and handed over to the Djibouti Coast Guard on Jan 12.
