Escort operations as the Counter-Piracy Operation off the Coast of Somalia and in the Gulf of Aden (JAN 2024)

#### Record of Mission

### 1. Direct Escort

- (1) Number of direct escort operations: 2
- (2) Number of escorted vessels: 3 (Accumulated Total (AT) of 3,955 escorted vessels since the start of operations under Japan's Anti-Piracy Measures Law)

### [Breakdown]

- Japanese-registered ships: 0 (AT: 26)
- Foreign ships operated by Japanese shipping companies: 0 (AT: 701) (Foreign ships which carry Japanese nationals: 0 (AT: 51)
- Foreign ships other than above: 3 (AT: 3,228)
  - \*The record above does not include the 1st 41st escort operation performed as Maritime Security Activities.

### 2. Zone Defense

- (1) Number of days: 18 days (AT: 2, 690days)
- (2) Number of commercial vessels confirmed: 198 vessels (AT: 33.242 vessels)

## 3. Action in Response to Incidents

Receiving information that "GIBRALTAR EAGLE", a Marshall-Islands flagged American-owned cargo ship, was struck by an anti-ship ballistic missile in the Gulf of Aden on January 15, the shipboard helicopter of JS "AKEBONO" from our counter-piracy enforcement communicated with the vessel. The information gathered was provided to the Combined Task Force 151, which is in charge of counter-piracy missions.
