- PLA and AFRF bombers conducted a long-distance joint flight over the Sea of Japan, East China Sea, and Pacific Ocean for two days.
- The landings and takeoffs of carrier-based fighters from PLA aircraft carrier "Liaoning" and "Shandong" over the Pacific were observed.
- Russian Tu-95 bombers flew over the Sea of Japan.






Flight Patterns of Russian Aircraft and Chinese Aircraft (Ex)
