Event Summary/Russian Military Activities

March 7, 2025

A Russian Navy vessel sailed through waters in Japan's southwest.

- At around 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, March 4, 2025, JMSDF spotted a RFN Vishnya-class AGI (hull number 535) sailing westward in the waters approximately 80 km southwest of Okinawa Main Island.
- The RFN AGI continued to sail in Japan's contiguous zone from southwest of Okinawa Main Island to west of Tori-shima Island, and sailed into the East China Sea.
- This is the same vessel sailed southwestward through Tsushima Strait from February 16 to 17, 2025, and sailed in the waters from north of Tori-shima Island to southeast of Okinawa Main Island, including inside Japan's contiguous zone, from February 19 to 20, 2025.
- JMSDF assets monitored the activities of the vessel.
