PACIFIC PARTNERSHIP 2022

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2022 (IPD22) unit will participate in U.S. led "PACIFIC PARTNERSHIP 2022" with U.S. Navy, U.S. Coast Guard, Royal Navy and Palau's Division of Maritime Security and Fish and Wildlife Protection, Bureau of Public Safety, Ministry of Justice (DMSFWP) in order to strengthen cooperation and to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific" as described below.
