Japan-U.S. Bilateral Exercise (ILEX22-6)

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2022 (IPD22) unit, JS *IZUMO* and JS *TAKANAMI* conducted a bilateral exercise with the U.S. Navy in order to strengthen the capability of Japan-U.S. Alliance for effective deterrence and response as described below.
