U.S., Australia, and Philippine led Multilateral Exercise  
(Exercise SAMASAMA/LUMBUS 2022)

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2022 (IPD22) unit, JS *KIRISAME* and US-2, participated in a multilateral exercise “Exercise SAMASAMA/LUMBUS 2022” hosted by the United States Navy (USN), the Royal Australian Navy (RAN) and the Philippine Navy (PN) in order to strengthen cooperation and to realize a “Free and Open Indo-Pacific” as described below.
