Japan-U.S. Bilateral Exercise

The JMSDF conducted a bilateral exercise with the U.S. Navy (USN) in order to strengthen the capability of Japan-U.S. Alliance for effective deterrence and response as described below.

- 1. Objectives
- (1) To improve the JMSDF's tactical capabilities
- (2) To improve interoperability between the JMSDF and the USN
- 2. Period

January 15 - 23

From south of Kanto to in the vicinity of Okinawa via south of Shikoku

- 4. Participating units

- (2) USN: USS ANTIETAM, USS CHANCELLORSVILLE, USS SHILOH, USS RAFAEL PERALTA, USNS JOHN ERICSSON, USNS WASHINGTON CHAMBERS
- 5. Type of exercise

Tactical exercise (Anti-Air Warfare Exercise, Anti-Surface Warfare Exercise, Anti-Submarine Warfare Exercise), Replenishment at Sea, etc.
