Japan-U.S.-ROK Trilateral Exercise

The JMSDF conducted a trilateral exercise with the U.S. Navy (USN) and the Republic of Korea Navy (ROKN) in order to strengthen deterrence and response capabilities of the Japan-U.S. Alliance and advance Japan-U.S-ROK trilateral security coordination as described below.
