Japan-U.S.-Australia-Canada Multilateral Exercise "NOBLE WOLF"

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2023 (IPD23) unit, JS *SHIRANUI* and P-1 conducted a multilateral exercise with the United States Navy (USN), the Royal Australian Navy (RAN), and the Royal Canadian Navy (RCN) in order to strengthen cooperation to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific" as described below.

- (2) To strengthen cooperation with the participating navies
