Japan-US-Australia-Philippine Quadrilateral Exercise

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2023 (IPD23) units conducted a Quadrilateral exercise with the United States Navy (USN), the Royal Australian Navy (RAN), the Royal Australian Air force (RAAF) and the Philippine Navy (PN) in order to strengthen cooperation to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific" as described below.
