Japan-Australia-India-U.S. Multilateral Exercise (MALABAR 2024)

The Indo-Pacific Deployment 2024 (IPD24) unit will participate in a multilateral exercise "MALABAR 2024" with the Royal Australian Navy (RAN), the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF), the Indian Navy (IN), and the U.S. Navy (USN) as described below in order to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific".

- (1) Exercise Malabar originally started as bilateral exercise between the USN and the IN in 1992. The JMSDF was invited to the exercise in 2007, and has been participating ever since. This will be out 13th participation.
